As a non-profit art space run by a dedicated committee of volunteer artists and arts workers, Trocadero strives to provide a safe and engaging environment for artists to exhibit in, develop from, and contribute to the Maribyrnong community.

Due to COVID-19, the gallery is currently closed and focussing on supporting artists and engaging the public via online content, as well as undertaking organisational planning and development.

About the Role

The Public Programs Coordinator works with the Trocadero team and wider community to coordinate the development and delivery of our public programs. During COVID-19 there is a strong emphasis on coordinating digital content, with a focus on our <u>Troc Talks Online program</u>.

As the Public Programs Coordinator you will communicate with artists to develop their program ideas, often assisting with the format of artist talks and experimental content. Alongside this, you will assist other Trocadero committee members with special programs throughout the year.

- Consulting with committee staff to develop a program of events
- Regular and timely communication with artists via email, online meetings or other
- Scheduling programs in collaboration with marketing/promotions staff
- Developing guiding questions for artists in preparation for artist talks
- Conducting interviews with artists or participating in other programs
- Coordinating program delivery and rostering staff where needed
